CORAL MOTIF

Celebrity makeup artist Bruce Grayson, whose clients include Katie Holmes and Sharon Stone, gives us the lowdown on this season's hot shade, coral—and the right way to use bronzer.—*Dawn Shand Johnson*

What's the best way to wear the coral look this summer?

Coral is a great color for summer because it looks so fresh. The color brightens the face—alone, as a sheer wash over the top of cheekbones, or it looks fantastic when paired up with a bronze shader under the cheekbone. Try Benefit

powder blush in Coralista for a sheer, shimmering accent of color, or use Tarte Topsy on the inner cheeks for organic translucency.

What's the right way to wear bronzer?

Avoid bronzers with too much shimmer, as they tend to add texture and highlight skin imper-

fections. Instead, use a matte bronzer and medium blush brush to shade your cheeks and jawline. Use a mini flat bronzer brush and round, circular motion to apply a dusting of color over the entire face. I like Guerlain Terracotta Bronzing Powder, which comes in a variety of natural-looking colors.

CALIFORNIA GIRL BROWS

"DURING WARMER MONTHS, BROWS GROW MORE QUICKLY, SO IT WILL BE EASY TO EMBRACE THIS SEASON'S 1960S 'CALIFORNIA GIRL' LOOK AND OPT FOR A FULLER, MORE NATURAL BROW.

A clean, well-maintained, classic-shaped brow will brighten and open up the look of your face. Start off by evening your skin tone with a concealer or light liquid foundation; then brush on a tawny-colored blush or bronzer (try my signature powder—it's smooth and light, just right for summer). Next, if you use a pencil to highlight the brow bone, use either a beige or light-pink pencil, and draw a line directly under the brow along the brow bone, then blend color with a small, firm brush. If you use a cream shadow, apply a few dabs of a light beige or soft pearl shade directly under the arch with your fingertip or a small foundation brush. And remember, never over-tweeze. If you're not sure what hairs to pull, put the tweezers down. Between visits to a brow specialist, keep your brows under control by tweezing obvious hairs that have grown below the actual brow line and between the eyebrows." —Karen Scott, brow expert, Karen Scott Cosmetics, 310-553-5126, KarenScottCosmetics.com
